OKI Island Life Experience



Experience a slow island lifestyle at a small fishing village in the Oki Islands!

Visit the family of a fisherman living in a fishing village in the Oki Islands (Dōgo Island). You will cook and eat lunch with the fisherman and his wife, go for a walk, take your time watching the sea and forget about everything; in other words, experience what it is like to live on an island.



Program Highlights

① Visit a fisherman's house

You will visit the house of a fisherman living in a small village in the Yui area of Dōgo Island, in the Oki Islands. First, you will spend time together and hear about daily life in the house and on the island. You will be received with Japanese tea and sweets.

② "Various experiences"

You will be informed of the experiences available on that day, depending on the weather. On shallow beaches, you will be able to experience being a fisherman and catch turban shells (*sazae*) and octopuses. You will also take a walk in this small village, taking your time to slowly enjoy.

③ Cooking

You will use the catch you made with the fisherman and try actually making Japanese home-style dishes like *sashimi* (raw fish).

④ Relax and feel the island

With a view of the sea before you, you will taste the homemade food you actually prepared. For as long as time allows, enjoy interacting with the fisherman and your time on the island. Depending on time, you may be able to see the sunset.



Details

This plan includes transportation, with Saigō Port as the place of meeting and dismissal. Chartered taxi, experience program (the cooking experience is the base program; other experiences vary). A guide-interpreter (English) will accompany you.
