OKI Folk Song Experience



Experience the island's folk song and dance in a cafe in the Oki Islands!

Have lunch in the town of Saigō, gateway to the Oki Islands (Dōgo Island), in a riverside cafe run by a lady who plays an active role in the island. As a special treat, you will experience *shamisen* music, traditional folk songs, and the Sara Odori dance. Enjoy connecting with the people of the island.



Program Highlights

① Enjoy the island's cuisine

You will be guided to a Japanese-style house that has been remodeled into a cafe. Here you will enjoy delicious food made with local island ingredients. You will also eat the popular dish "Oki soba noodles."



② Listen to folk songs

After the meal, you will hear the traditional folk songs passed down in the Oki Islands, accompanied by a performance of the *shamisen*, a traditional three-stringed instrument.

③ Experience dancing

You will experience the Sara Odori together, dancing with small plates, a traditional dance handed down in the island.

④ And communicate

Through lunch at the cafe, the *shamisen* music, and the dancing experience, this program will enable you to communicate across language boundaries with the local people.
