OKI Oki Islands Geopark Tour



Learn about the origin of the islands on a caldera, rare in the world!

Take a chartered taxi to Mt. Akahage and Sekiheki (Red Cliff), enjoying the scenery while a guide tells you about the islands' origin. On the way, you can capture photos of grazing cows and occasional *tanuki* (raccoon dogs).



Program Highlights

① A close look at cows and horses

On the way, grazing cows and horses may approach the car. Sometimes you can see calves and even *tanuki* (raccoon dogs).

② Feel geo (the Earth)

You can get a close look at the islands around the rare caldera. At the cliff, you can see dozens of overlapping strata (layers) and learn about the formation of the islands.

③ Encounter the historical island life

You can see the remnants of Oki's unique agricultural *makihata* fields, feeling the life of islanders who have coexisted with nature.

④ Geopark guide

A geopark guide (English) will accompany you during the tour to explain the origin of the island, including the geography, topography, and geology of Oki.

Meet at the gateway to the island, Kurii Port.

Drop-off may be to the port or your hotel.

An guide-interpreter (English) will accompany you.
