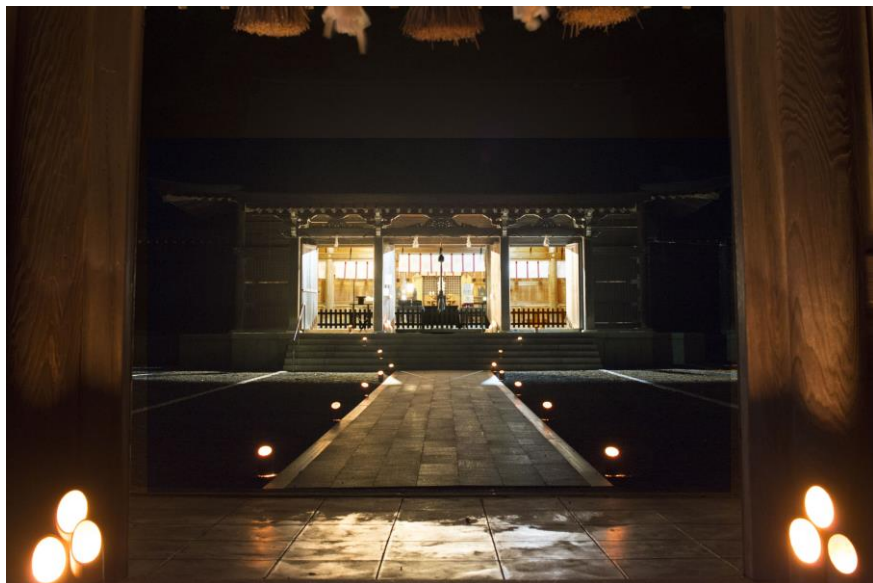

OKI Oki Shrine Night Visit



Visit a shrine in the clear and calm air of the night.

Oki Shrine was built to enshrine former Emperor Go-Toba 700 years after his death. The shrine is enveloped in the light of bamboo lanterns at night. Join the prayer in the clear of the night under the leadership of the priest, and receive your own protective charm.



Program Highlights

① Learn about Japanese Shinto

Before the visit, the priest will give an easy to understand explanation of Shinto.

② Fantastic atmosphere

The tranquil grounds illuminated by bamboo lanterns will allow you to feel a fantastic atmosphere.

③ A protective charm of your own

After receiving a full-scale prayer by the priest, you can take home your own protective charm.

Details

The meeting place is Oki Shrine; transportation is charged separately. Prayer and protective charm fees are included. A guide-interpreter (English) will accompany you.
