Daisen/Mt. Daisen Downhill Cycling



Why not cycle downhill from 780 meters to 0 meters ASL?

Enjoy cycling on a zigzag road under the sunlight that comes through the leaves of trees, or a straight road in the midst of a lawn, slowly heading for the sea. There is no uphill road. You can interact with local people on the way while drinking tea, and enjoy dishes made from freshly-caught fish at the destination.



Experience in Mt. Daisen Downhill Cycling



1. Easy Cycling

You can enjoy easy cycling. There is no uphill road. Downhill all the way from 780 meters above sea level, halfway up Mt. Daisen, to 0 meters above sea level. It is a very refreshing ride.

2. Exchange with Local People

Have a tea break at a riding club that looks out over the northern cliff of Mt. Daisen on your way. Enjoy interaction with local people, drinking tea made from tea leaves produced in that region.

3. View of the Mountain and the Sea

You can have a view of the northern cliff of Mt. Daisen and a huge lawn from an observation deck on your way. On a clear day, the Oki Islands can be seen in the distance in the Sea of Japan.

4. Seafood from the Sea of Japan

You can enjoy seafood made from freshly-caught fish and other sea products at the destination of the downhill cycling, Mikuriya Fishing Port.

Details

The tour starts from Mori-no-kuni.

- Participation fee includes the rental fee of a bicycle, a helmet, and gloves.
- You are required to buy accident insurance.
- Lunch will be served. A guide interpreter (English-speaking) will accompany you.
